has passed away.

A resident of York, Alabama, Past President Green also served as a state senator and was a businessman. He was elected president at the association's 46th annual convention held in Miami, Florida, in 1963.

He had been a member of the York Lions Club since 1947 and served as president of the University of South Alabama.

Past International Director Milton H. Tuttle, of Prospect Heights, Illinois, has passed away.

A retired attorney and former Justice of the Peace and township tax collector, he had been a Lion since 1944 and was a Life Member of the Des Plaines Lions Club. He served on the International Board of Directors in 1976-78.

Past International Director Salvador Pugliese Insuela, of Montevideo, Uruguay, has passed away. A physician, he had been a member of the Montevideo-Pocitos Lions Club since 1956. He served on the International Board of Directors during 1987-89.
