

Past International President Per Stahl Passes Away



Past International President Per Gustav Stahl, of Eskilstuna, Sweden, passed away May 14.

His involvement with Lionism began in 1949, when he joined the Eskilstuna Lions Club, serving as charter club president. He was a Life Member of the club, and had also served as district governor and was a member of the International Board of Directors during 1953-55. Lion Stahl also served on the Board of International Relations and on the Executive Council of the Board of Governors.

His dedication to Lionism earned him many awards and honors during the years, including the Ambassador of Good Will and International President's Awards. He was also a Key Member.

In 1961, at the Atlantic City, New Jersey, International Convention, Per Stahl was elected President of The International Association of Lions Clubs.

In addition to his activities as a Lion, Past President Stahl had been a board member of both the merchant section of the Swedish General Export Association and the Eskilstuna section of the Swedish Commercial Travelers Association.

He is survived by his wife, Inger, and one son and two daughters.
